Please submit the following to be considered for the Altrusa scholarship:

- 1. Completed application form;
- 2. Letter from Applicant stating why Applicant is applying for this scholarship. This letter should accent the financial need as well as any community service performed;
- 3. Transcript of grades substantiating at least a B average;
- 4. College transcript if college courses taken;
- 5. Letter of recommendation from your high school principal or counselor;
- 6. Letters of recommendation from two additional persons (non-relatives) with whom Applicant is well acquainted. These letters of recommendation should substantiate qualifications and financial need of Applicant; and
- 7. Copy of SAT/ACT scores.

Failure to include <u>ALL</u> required items and fill out <u>ALL</u> questions will result in disqualification of Applicant. Failure to use correct application or to have all required items turned in by the deadline will result in disqualification of Applicant. If a question does not apply to you, please enter N/A or strike through it. The Applicant and Applicant's School will be notified if Applicant is chosen to receive an Altrusa Scholarship.

This application is due on <u>March 31st</u> and must be <u>received</u> no later than that date. <u>Late or incomplete applications received will not be considered for the scholarships.</u>
